- Fees can be paid via e-transfer (sent to: events@cowichanstation.org), cash or cheques (made out to CSAA- Cowichan Station Area Association).
- Cancellations made 48+ hours prior to the market will be refunded. Cancellations made less than 48 hours prior to the event are non-refundable.
- Booths are outside and are 10' x 10' in size. Vendors are asked to bring their own table, tent &/or chair (as applicable).
- All vendors are expected to meet Provincial Regulations – [food](#) or otherwise.
